CLIENT APPOINTMENT OPTIONS

Sound Health has three (3) appointment options available for clients:

1. Live On-Line Appointments with Sharry Edwards

These appointments are one-on-one with Sharry Edwards and usually take about ½ to 1 hour. The client can watch the appointment live, on-line using their computer. These sessions are \$125.00/hr and the client will receive a computerized report of the voice analysis and time with Sharry to explain the appropriate recommendations.

2. Wave File Submission for Evaluation

Clients can submit their own voice print for analysis using a wave file. Clients can download and use ***Audacity*** to record voice prints from www.audacity.sourceforge.net or use a sound recorder (included with Windows XP, but not with Vista) then email that wave file to vocalprofiling@gmail.com. Please include the specific issues you would like Sharry to address while analyzing the file. The analysis usually takes 30 minutes to two (2) hours and comes with a 4-10 page report for the client to review.

The cost for this voice print submission and analysis with Sharry is \$125.00/hour.

3. On-Site with a BioAcoustic Provider

This type of evaluation is done on-site with a trained BioAcoustic Provider. The client must fill out an application, and only specific types of cases are seen at the home office, and are often related to the research being conducted at the Institute at the time. Initial sessions usually requires 2-4 hours of the providers time, though only a small portion of that time is required by the client. A vocal print is taken and evaluated, formula sets are determined, tone trials are run and a tone box with the appropriate tones are programmed. A follow up the next day is required to ensure the tones are correct. A follow up appointment is necessary within three (3) days to determine progress or problems. Appointments with Sharry are \$125.00/ hour. Tone boxes are \$450.00 and include headphones. Appointment rates may vary depending on the practitioner and location.

Also, rates may vary if another provider at the Institute works with the client.
